

ORDINANCE NO. 2039-20

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER EXTENDING ORDINANCE NO. 1985-19 AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON ADULT-USE CANNABIS BUSINESSES PURSUANT TO PUBLIC ACT 101-0027 WHILE THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS REVIEWS POSSIBLE TEXT AMENDMENTS AS PART OF THE VILLAGE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF HAWTHORN WOODS

WHEREAS, on November 25, 2019 the Village of Hawthorn Woods enacted Ordinance 1985-19;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 1985-19 imposed a moratorium on all adult use cannabis businesses in order for the Village to review possible text amendments as part of the Village Code in the Village of Hawthorn Woods;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2020-20 extended Ordinance 1985-19, An Ordinance Imposing A Moratorium on Adult-Use Cannabis Businesses Pursuant to Public Act 101-0027 While the Village of Hawthorn Woods Reviews Possible Text Amendments As Part of the Village Code of the Village of Hawthorn Woods;

WHEREAS, since the adoption of Ordinance 1985-19 and Ordinance 2020-20 the Village has begun to review possible text amendments;

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Village and its staff have not been able to devote the necessary staff time and resources or conduct public meetings in order to properly consider this issue;

WHEREAS, the Village Board finds that it is appropriate and necessary to extend the moratorium so as to provide proper study and allow public input into the question of whether to permit adult use cannabis businesses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village of Hawthorn Woods, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth hereinabove are fully incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION TWO: The moratorium on adult use cannabis businesses imposed pursuant to Ordinance 1985-19 and extended by Ordinance 2020-20 is hereby extended until March 31, 2021 unless sooner modified or amended by the Village Board.

SECTION THREE: All other provisions of Ordinance 1985-19 and Ordinance 2020-20 remain in full force and effect unless specifically amended by the Village Board.

SECTION FOUR: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
